

## Rayovac and Rudolph Light Up This Holiday Season

Noted on the back of the box is, "Rudolph's nose powered by Rayovac."

The video's release will be also be supported at retail with a series of books by GoodTimes Publications and Golden Books Family Entertainment. Character plush toys will also be offered.
