

Rayovac's I-C3 Technology Makes 15-Minute Charger the First of its Kind

MADISON, Wis. – Rayovac, the number one selling rechargeable brand in the U.S., has announced that I-C3, the revolutionary new rechargeable Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH) battery and charging system will be available to consumers in the U.S. by October 2003. The new I-C3 rechargeable battery system is the only one of its kind to offer a charging time of an unprecedented 15 minutes or less, producing battery power so strong that it will last up to four times longer than an alkaline battery in a digital camera.

Rayovac's patent-pending I-C3 technologyÔ (In-Cell Charge Control) puts the control of recharging into the battery, instead of the charger. This breakthrough in NiMH technology offers significant performance and convenience advantages over existing rechargeable and disposable battery systems.

The new Rayovac 15-minute NiMH Rechargeable System will feature new batteries and two new chargers. The Rayovac 15-Minute Rechargeable batteries will be available in AA and AAA sizes. Battery two-packs will be priced under \$10, and four-packs under \$15. The two-position and four-position chargers will charge AA or AAA Rayovac I-C3 NiMH batteries in as little as 15 minutes and up to 1,000 times. The two-position charger is expected to be priced under \$25 and the four-position charger under \$35. In addition, the four-position charger will offer a car cord adapter that will allow 15-minute charging in the car. The car cord can be obtained via a back by mail option in certain packages or by calling Rayovac consumer services at 1-800-237-7000.

"This groundbreaking technology is going to change the way people view rechargeable battery systems, especially in terms of digital cameras," said Jerry Albright, Rayovac divisional vice president, marketing, rechargeables and specialty batteries. "It's perfect for people with busy lifestyles. The power, convenience, and price of the 15-Minute Rechargeable System make it the premier battery product not only for digital cameras, but for devices such as PDAs, toys and CD or MP3 players as well."
